FINCA LAS DIVAS

Altitude: 1350 m.a.s.l

Soil: Alluvial origin, Sandy-loam texture interwoven with boulders coming from the descent of the Las Tunas river. They are poor in organic matter and have excellent drainage. Thus, the vineyard explores the deepest layers of the soil and settles pronounced roots.

Composition: 34% Malbec (own mass selection) 33% Cabernet Sauvignon 33% (clone 169) Cabernet Franc (own mass selection) all varieties with rootstock Pauls. 1103

Plots: C8, C5, C10, C11 of Finca Las Divas

TASTING NOTES

This great cut represents the work done for generations in our vineyard "Finca Las Divas". It is deep red mixed with violet and black shades. A wine of great sensory complexity, with spices appearing as a wide palette of black fruits. In the palate it is gray, broad and elegant. Tannins are harmonic and balanced with their natural acidity. Its end is persistent and complex, with great potential to gain intricacy during its cellaring.
